Sealed Bids for the “Summer Street Gas Station Park Project” will be received by the Office of Community & Economic Development located at 66 Central Square, Bridgewater, MA 02324 until 10:00 AM local time on March 25, 2026, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Sealed Bids must have an outer envelope marked as “Summer Street Gas Station Park Project.”

The work consists of the removal of existing impervious surface areas, landscaping, renovation of two (2) existing bathrooms (one (1) to be ADA compliant), drainage improvements and the addition of new pervious surface areas.

All Bids for this project are subject to the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30, Section 39M, as amended.

Responses to all questions received by Bidders will be compiled and emailed to all registered bidders by 4:00 PM on March 19, 2026, in the form of an Addendum. Failure of a Bidder to acknowledge receiving addenda may result in bid rejection.

An optional Pre-Bid Site Visit Meeting will be held at the property, 46 Summer Street, Bridgewater, MA on March 16, 2026, at 10:00 AM.

All bids must be submitted on printed hard copies of the PDF Bid Documents obtained via email. Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department Workforce Development under the provision of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Sections 26 to 27D, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the Contractor to ensure their bid is based upon the prevailing wage rate schedule for all trades people who may be employed for the proposed work under the Contract.
