TOWN OF BRIDGEWATER

WINTER STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT 2026 (RE-BID)

Sealed Bids for the “Winter Street Improvement Project 2026 Re-Bid” will be received by the Department of Public Works at their offices located at, 25 South Street, Bridgewater, MA 02324 until 2:00 P.M. local time on April 15th, 2026, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. Sealed Bids must have outer envelope marked as “Winter Street Improvement Project 2026 Re-Bid.”

The work consists of the removal and abandonment of deteriorating corrugated metal drainage pipe (CMP). The construction of a new drainage system consisting of reinforced concrete pipe (RCP), precast manholes & catch basins, a headwall, and precast drywells and appurtenances within a major Town roadway. Existing catchbasins will also be removed and disposed of and drain manholes will be abandoned in place. This project also includes full depth roadway reconstruction and re-alignment of Winter Street as shown on the plans, water service relocations, restoration of driveway aprons, tree removal, and lawn restoration. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis as indicated in the Bid Form.

All Bids for this project are subject to the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30, Section 39M as amended. The project is funded by Chapter 90 State funds. MassDOT prequalification of contractors with the class of work as “DRAINAGE” for the project with an estimated value of \$ 1,505,028.50 will be required.

Bid Documents will be available on March 11, 2026. Bid Documents may be obtained electronically by emailing the Engineer Gregory Tansey from the Department of Public Works at gtansey@bridgewaterma.org. All bids must follow the bid submission procedure listed herein below. An optional Pre Bid Site Visit Meeting will be held at the intersection of Winter Street and Conant Street in Bridgewater, MA on March 18, 2026, at 11:00 AM. All questions relating to the Pre Bid Site Visit Meeting and the bid documents and specifications must also be directed to this e-mail address by 4:00 PM March 25, 2026. Responses to all RFI questions received by Bidders will be compiled and e-mailed to all registered Bidders by 4:00 PM on April 1, 2026 in the form of an Addendum. Failure of a Bidder to acknowledge receiving addenda may result in a bid rejection.

Bidders may purchase hard copies of the Bid Documents at the Bridgewater DPW Offices located at 25 South Street, Bridgewater, MA 02324 with a \$100.00 check made payable to the Town of Bridgewater. All bids must be submitted on printed hard copies of the PDF Bid Documents obtained via e-mail or from hard copies purchased from the Bridgewater DPW.

Massachusetts Prevailing Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Workforce Development under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27D, as amended, apply to this project. Bidders must submit their bids based upon the current prevailing wage rate schedule for all trades people employed under this Contract.
