Local electricity supply with price stability, consumer choice, and cleaner options

What is Municipal Aggregation?

A Town-run electricity **buying program** that pools residents and small businesses to negotiate the **supply** portion of your bill. Your **utility** (National Grid) still delivers power, maintains the grid, and responds to outages. Only the "Supply" line item may change.

Why Now: Price Outlook & Stability

- Stability in a volatile market. Utility Basic Service prices reset every 6 months, which can cause swings. Aggregation can lock a fixed rate for a longer term to help households budget with confidence. (Our program offers a set price for 35 months)
- **Upward pressure on prices.** National and regional forecasts point to higher electricity demand and continued New England winter volatility. A Town-timed competitive bid helps us **manage risk** and avoid chasing seasonal spikes.
- No promise of monthly savings—promise of predictability. While
 month-to-month savings over the utility can't be guaranteed, aggregation is
 designed to deliver price stability and transparency.

What Stays the Same

- Same utility for delivery, maintenance, and outage response.
- Same bill format—your utility still bills you.
- No change to your service quality or meter reading.

What's New

- A Town-selected default product with a fixed price and a clear term.
- Optional **cleaner electricity** products (e.g., extra MA Class I renewable energy) you can choose.

• **Local control** over products and timing, plus transparent posting of prices and renewable content on the program website.

Consumer Protections

- Advance notice. Before enrollment, the Town will mail an opt-out letter with the price, term, and renewable content. You'll have at least 30 days to opt out penalty-free before anything changes.
- You're in control. You can opt out at any time with no fee, switch between products, or re-join later with no fees or penalties from the Town program.
- No door-to-door selling from the Town's program—official notices come by mail and are posted online.

How to Participate

- 1. Watch your mail. Look for the opt-out letter with the program price and term.
- 2. **Do nothing to join** the default product—or **choose** an optional greener product on the program website.
- 3. Prefer to stay with Basic Service? Opt out—no penalty.

Key Facts at a Glance

- **Goal:** Stable, predictable supply pricing; local control; cleaner options (3 overall options).
- **Term:** single or multi-year fixed price (35 months for this initial offering).
- Cost transparency: Price, renewable content, and fees are clearly disclosed.
- Who's eligible: All residents and small businesses in Bridgewater.
