#### **Project Summary**

Planning for the Bridgewater Pickle Ball courts were in the planning stages for several years prior to

Charlie Simonds' work to secure Community Preservation Act funds.

The CPC recommended that the Council appropriate \$112,450 to offset the costs of site development,

court construction and required shelter.

Although Mr. Simonds passed away very soon after the courts were completed, his work continues to be enjoyed by a large contingent of residents and visitors who are passionate pickle ball players.

The Community Preservation money of \$112,450 funded the construction of six courts and the pavilion shelter which provides shade and seating for players while they await court time.
