## Memorandum of Agreement Between The Town of Bridgewater And Bridgewater Firefighters Association, Local 2611 I.A.F.F

WHEREAS, the Town of Bridgewater (Town) and the Bridgewater Firefighters Association, Local 2611 I.A.F.F (BFA) are parties to a collective bargaining agreement (Agreement) that expired by its terms on June 30, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Town, and the BFA have reached an understanding for a new contract for the period of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2024.

The Town and BFA agree as follows:

## ARTICLE V - Holidays

**SECTION 1.** - Days designated as Holidays (*not to be accumulated*) under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts shall be.

New Year's Day Labor Day

Martin Luther King Day Columbus Day/Indigenous Peoples' Day

Washington's Birthday National First Responders Day

Patriot's Day Veterans' Day

Memorial Day Thanksgiving Day

Juneteenth Christmas Day

Independence Day

## **ARTICLE XVII - Compensation**

The Town in recognition of the service of the Fire service team members during the Covid-19 pandemic will provide a one-time payment of \$3,500.00 in Year 1 of the contract.

SECTION 1a. There shall be an increase to the employee's Base Hourly Rate of pay of 1.75% effective on July 1, 2021, and an increase of 2.00% effective on July 1, 2022, 2.0% effective on July 1, 2023.

SECTION 2. Effective, July 1, 2022, employees who obtain and maintain the following certifications shall receive a differential and is part of the aggregate which comprises the employee's base hourly rate of pay as outlined below:

- EMT-B shall receive a differential rate of 13.50%.
- EMT-I shall receive a differential rate of 15.50%.
- EMT-P shall receive a differential rate of 17.50%

## **SECTION 5. - Detail Rates**

Day Detail Rate: The Day Detail Rate shall be set at \$60.00 per hour.

- Any firefighter working a detail shall receive a four (4) hour minimum.
- In the event the detail continues after the first four (4) consecutive hours, the firefighter shall receive a six (6) hour minimum.
- In the event the detail continues after six (6) consecutive hours, the firefighter shall be paid hour for hour.

Night Detail Rate: Any detail requested between the 2000 and 0600 hours (8:00PM - 6:00AM) shall be billed at a rate of \$80 per hour.

Weekend and Holiday Detail Rate: Any firefighter working a detail that falls on a Saturday, Sunday or Holiday (as defined in Article V - Holidays) shall be paid at a rate of \$80 per hour.

Youth Sports: All youth sports events will be billed at a rate of \$60.00 per hour.

All benefits afforded and earned from previous agreement will remain in full effect until agreements is ratified and signed by both parties.
