Subject: SSO Public Notification

In accordance with MassDEP 314 CMR 16.00, we are notifying the public of a sanitary sewer overflow (SSO) that began on August 23, 2023, at the Bridgewater Morris Avenue Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). At approximately 9:30 PM on Wednesday, August 23, 2023, the Town of Bridgewater found their chlorine disinfection system was malfunctioning due to a broken gas regulator. For safety, the Town Operations team immediately turned off the chlorine disinfection system and ordered a replacement gas regulator. The new regulator arrived at approximately 8:00 AM. The Town Operations team installed the new regulator and resumed chlorine disinfection at approximately 8.15 AM on Thursday, August 24, 2023. The Morris Ave. WWTF discharged approximately 371,000 gallons of (not chlorinated) effluent through its discharge into the Town River between 9:30 PM on Wednesday, August 23 and 8:15 AM Thursday, August 24. Impacts to local waterbodies that would pose health risks from bacteria and other pollutants may have occurred.
